And I will do your will.

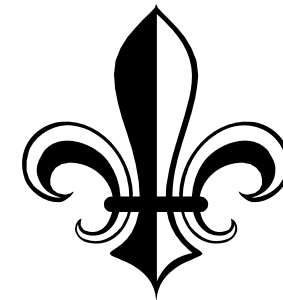
Right: I rise before dawn and cry for help,
